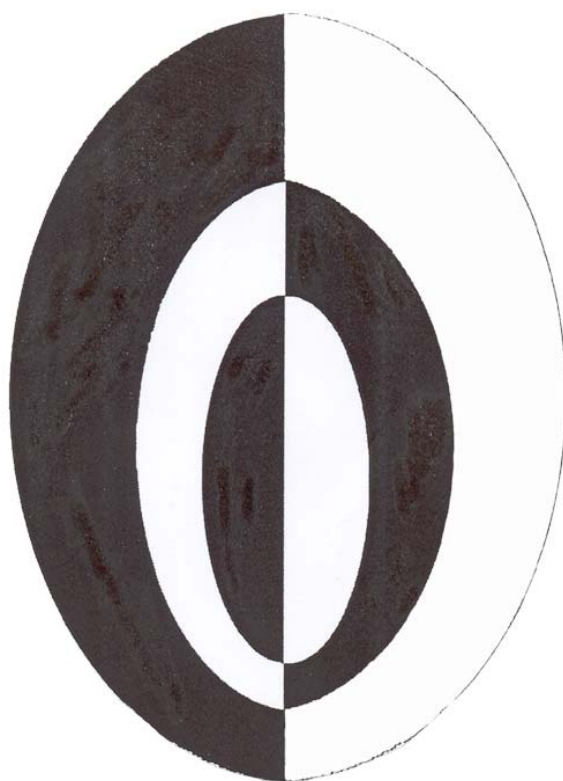

We are an autonomous charity covering the entire county of Norfolk. We work closely and in partnership with local, regional and national statutory & voluntary bodies to address issues of inequality and discrimination.

- Assist your organisation in developing and implementing equal opportunities and anti-racist policies and procedures.
